### PERMISSION LETTER (BUS)

Dear Parents:

Wingate High School will continue to provide transportation for residential students every Friday, and Sunday for students who live on the Albuquerque Route. If your child goes home on the bus on Friday, you are now required to bring your child back to school every Sunday. There are too many absences on Mondays, so please bring your child back on Sunday. Your child is required to be in school from Monday to Friday. Early checkouts are also discouraged.

Parents should be aware that school transportation operates only on the main roads and we need input from parents as to where the student should be dropped off. Parents may give special information or travel information concerning their child by calling the school at (505)488-6408 on weekdays or (505)488-6436 on weekends.

We will do everything we can to assure that your child gets off the bus at the place you designated on the Dorm Registration Form. Any student who abuses the procedures will lose their privilege to ride the bus, which includes all major violations of the Student Code of Conduct. Parents may revoke this authorization at any time by calling the school at (505)488-6400.
