

The following items are allowed in the residential halls:

School supplies:

The students are expected to bring their own school supplies, (i.e., pencils, pens, notebook paper, portfolio folders, binders, monthly planners, calculators, etc). Please encourage your child to be responsible these supplies.

Personal supplies:

All students need to bring personal hygiene products (i.e., shampoo, face/hand soap, lotion, toothpaste and toothbrush). Students may bring electronic devices, (i.e., personal CD players, small stereos, cell phones, palm pilots, hand held DVD players) to the residential halls ONLY. The residential halls provide bed linens, but students may bring his/her own if they so desire. However, towels and personal hygiene products are not provided.

IMPORTANT

We do not always have enough facilities to keep things from being stolen. Do not allow your child to bring valuable items such as large stereos, laptops or large amounts of cash to the residential hall and school. If extra money is needed, we will inform the student and parent beforehand.

The following items are not allowed on the entire campus of Wingate High School:

Bandanas, spandex caps, black clothing depicting drugs/gangs, chains attached to wallets or keys, sharp objects, pocket knives, hair nets, skateboards and television.

Two-way radios are not allowed and will be confiscated and turned over to law enforcement and will not be returned to the student.

No student is allowed bring items to school campus for intent to use, sell or solicit at any time which can be considered weapons, drugs, alcohol or items which can be considered harmful to the health or safety of any individual, or which are in violation of any part of the Student Code of Conduct or any local, state or federal law. Such items are fireworks, lighters, matches, correction fluid, markers, paint, stink bombs, water balloons, shaving cream, spray paint, knives, guns, clubs, bats, pepper spray, mace, cough syrup, aerosol hair spray, or dust spray.

RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM (after 5:00pm)

Students may relax and change into their casual clothing. However the following rules will apply:

No gang related clothing. (No colored handkerchiefs "rags", no hairnet, no head spandex, no baggy clothing, no gang colors)

DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

A student who is *non-compliant* will be charged with *Code 312 -Improper Clothing Hygiene* (major violation). The student will not be allowed to attend classes until dressed according to the guidelines in the uniform policy above. If non-compliance continues, a Home Referral or Suspension will be initiated for the student.

Gang related clothing items will be confiscated and *will not be returned* to the student.
